

CONTRACT ACADEMIC DETAILER / PRESCRIBER EDUCATOR

Job Description:

The Maine Medical Association, on behalf of the Maine Independent Clinical Information Service (MICIS), is seeking a clinical health professional to serve in the role of a contract academic detailer. Academic detailing entails offering independent, scientific evidence on prescription drugs at the request of prescribers.

The per diem contract academic detailer will conduct face-to-face and virtual educational outreach visits to present the current evidence on best clinical prescribing practices. The candidate will be available for one-on-one consultations with prescribers and group education sessions at practices, hospitals, and conferences across the state. Some travel within Maine may be required for in-person meetings.

Hours required will vary from month to month, based on demand, and may range from 4 to 15 hours a month, occasionally with additional hours for conferences or meetings. Flexibility and ability to provide education sessions between 7am to 7pm on weekdays and occasionally on weekends is required. One-year contract subject to renewal.

Requirements:

- Clinical background: Licensed medical prescriber such as MD, DO, PA, NP with an active DEA registration or PharmD preferred; will consider other clinical background.
- Three or more years of clinical experience.
- Therapeutic competency.
- Strong interpersonal skills including service-orientation.
- Advanced presentation and public speaking skills.
- Advanced research and development skills for education materials and presentations on selected topics.
- No financial relationships with commercial interests, specifically ACCME defined "ineligible companies."
- Available to attend training (virtually or in Boston) on the principles and techniques of academic detailing. Additional training on specific clinical topics may take place periodically in Maine or Boston.
- Ability for light lifting when delivering presentation materials to sites.
- Ability to travel throughout the state including occasional long days driving and overnight stays in Maine or Boston.
- Ability to attend monthly work group meetings and quarterly advisory committee meetings virtually or in-person in Manchester, Maine.

Pay: The contractor will be paid on an hourly basis commensurate with the candidate's background and skills.
